Look for the Fish:

Are you looking for the fish?



Where are those in your world you can reach?

Position ourselves near the fish!

Sometimes the fish are in the most difficult part of the lake.

Are we willing to <u>GO</u> to the difficult places to reach people?



Wisdom of Drawing in:

Different fish are drawn to different things (good and bad). To be effective, recognise what is going to draw in the fish.

What draws people in to hearing about Jesus?

Holy Spirit at work and my availability!

- Be likeable... What are their interests? Spiritual appetite?

Be willing to take time to understand and relate to people.

Wisdom of Drawing in:

What are their interests? - Be willing to take time to understand and relate to people.

²¹ To those outside the law I became as one outside the law... that I might win those outside the law.

People are drawn to spiritual authenticity:

The Holy Spirit – works in us and draws people to us.

- The evidence of the Holy Spirit in us that people can see.

What makes us stand out?

¹⁵ Our lives are a Christ-like fragrance rising up to God. But this fragrance is perceived differently by those who are being saved and by those who are perishing. ¹⁶ ... to those who are being saved, we are a life-giving perfume. - 2 Corinthians 2:15-16 (NLT)

Landing the Catch:

Learn when to challenge – God's Timing.

- Pull too quickly, they're gone.
- Don't push enough, we lose them.

Sometimes it takes multiple people to land the fish. "⁶I (Paul) planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. ⁷So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth." - 1 Corinthians 3:6-7

With fishing it takes patience - a journey can take time.
