
# Leviticus 23

- Passover (Pesach) – Nissan 14
- Unleavened Bread (Chag Hamotzi) – Nisan 15-22
- First Fruits (Yom habikkurim) – Nisan 16
- Pentecost (Shavu'ot) – Sivan 6
- Trumpets (Yom Teru'ah) – Tishri 1
- Atonement (Yom Kippur) – Tishri 10
- Tabernacles (Sukkot) – Tishri 15

## The Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur) Lev 23:27

- A day of confession – the highest of high holy days.
- A feast of solemn confession and repentance - 10 days after the feast of trumpets.
- Lev 16:1-34 details
- The Sin Offering and the Scapegoat
- Propitiation and Expiation
- “Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him!” Romans 5:9

## Seventh: The Feast of Tabernacles – Sukkot – Feast of booths Lev 23:34

- 5 days later – 15<sup>th</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month.
- Jewish people required to build little shelters or booths outside their main house and live, eat and sleep there, reminding them of the time when they were provided shelter for them for 40 years in the wilderness.
- Certain types of plants and fruit are associated.
