Connect:

- 1. What is the fastest thing in the world?
- Visibility: Protects, draws, enables action, creates trust
- > Darkness: Hides, deceives, can lead to uncertainty and fear
- > Darkness is the opposite of visibility

Engage:

- 2. Read and discuss Luke 8:16-18
- 3. To those who listen more understanding will be given. To those not listening, even what they have will be taken away.
 - a. Similar expression to the Parable of the Talents Matthew 25:29
 - b. Similar expression to the Parable of the 10 Servants Luke 19:26
 - c. Similar idea to the discussion about judging Luke 6:37-38 and Matthew 7:1-
- 4. Ask yourself, "am I spending enough time in God's Word?"
- 5. Read Genesis 1:1-3 (God's Second Miracle)

- 9. What was Jesus drawing attention to?
- Jesus is referred to as Light elsewhere in scripture <u>Isaiah 9:2</u>; <u>10:17</u>, <u>42:6</u>, <u>49:6</u>, <u>Luke</u> 2:32
- 10. Read Matthew 5:14-16
- 11. What was the point of the lamp in the earlier Parable and now in Matthew 5?

- 13. What are two things that can diminish our light?
- 14. What things have you allowed to dull your light?
- 15. What is God's challenge to us?
- Do what we can to carry our faith visibly, but with humility

- He will do everything to lift "us! to a place to shed more light!
- 16. Read Luke 11:31
- The Queen of Sheba responded when she heard about Solomon and his great wisdom given by God; she went to see for herself.
- Modern historians identify Sheba with the South Arabian kingdom of Saba in present-day Yemen.
- 17. Read <u>Luke 11:33</u>
- With the same reference to the lamp placed on a stand, is the importance of Solomon being visible to the nations so that people could respond and enquire.
- 18. Read 1 Kings 10:1-6
- 19. Does visibility matter?
- Light makes everything visible: "for the light makes everything visible." Ephesians 3:14
- Not about me but Jesus: "He must become greater and greater, and I must become less and less." John 3:30
- ➤ Positioned to be visible: "For once you were full of darkness, but now you have light from the Lord. So live as people of light!" Ephesians 5:8
- ➤ God will lift us up: "Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up in honour." James 4:10
