To Pursue...

"Suggests a continuing effort to chase, reach, attain, or overtake someone or something."

Synonyms: Seek, run after, persist, search out, track down...

Proverbs 21:21 _{NLT} "Whoever <u>PURSUES</u> righteousness and unfailing love will <u>FIND</u> life, righteousness, and honour."

1. Pursuing God... Brings Unexpected Challenges

Jonah 1:1-3_{NLT}

¹The Lord gave this message to Jonah son of Amittai:

² "Get up and go to the great city of Nineveh. Announce my judgment against it because I have seen how wicked its people are." ³ But Jonah got up and went in the opposite direction to get away from the Lord. He went down to the port of Joppa, where he found a ship leaving for Tarshish. He bought a ticket and went on board, hoping to escape from the Lord by sailing to Tarshish.



2. Pursuing God... He Will Step In!

Jonah 1:4-6_{NIT}

⁴ But the LORD hurled a powerful wind over the sea, causing a violent storm that threatened to break the ship apart. ⁵ Fearing for their lives, the desperate sailors shouted to their gods for help and threw the cargo overboard to lighten the ship.

But all this time Jonah was sound asleep down in the hold. ⁶ So the captain went down after him. "How can you sleep at a time like this?" he shouted. "Get up and pray to your god! Maybe he will pay attention to us and spare our lives."



3. Pursuing God – Needs Reset Priorities

Jonah 2:7-10_{NLT}

"... ⁷ As my life was slipping away, I remembered the LORD. And my earnest prayer went out to you. ⁸ Those who worship false gods turn their backs on all God's mercies.

⁹ But I will offer sacrifices to you with songs of praise, and I will fulfil all my vows. For my salvation comes from the Lord alone."

¹⁰ Then the Lord ordered the fish to spit Jonah out onto the beach.



4. Pursuing God.... Unlocks Bigger Kingdom Purpose

Jonah 3:1-5 NIT

¹ Then the LORD spoke to Jonah a second time: ² "Get up and go to the great city of Nineveh, and deliver the message I have given you." This time Jonah obeyed the LORD's command and went to Nineveh, a city so large that it took three days to see it all. ⁴ On the day Jonah entered the city, he shouted to the crowds: "Forty days from now Nineveh will be destroyed!" ⁵ The people of Nineveh believed God's message, and from the greatest to the least, they declared a fast and put on burlap to show their sorrow.
