

ROCK Kids ZOOM Hangout

Naturally, meeting in this way presents different challenges as well as opportunities. As always, the safety of our group is paramount and so our Zoom meetings have been set up in such a way that ensures safety for all.

Please note the following:

- A waiting room is in operation, and the host will let children enter the Zoom room.
- The host/ROCK Team will have full access to mute all participants video or audio.
- The host/ROCK Team will be able to admit/remove children from the group.
- The group will only function when host/ROCK Team starts the meeting and end when they exit the meeting.
- Please make sure you are able to use the audio on your device (you may need to manually give the app permission in your phone/tablet/computer settings).
- **Please use your child's name as the zoom name (so the host can tell who is there and can communicate with the children by their correct name).**

For security, for each meeting we will send out information with the invitation link and password. Parents/guardians will always be copied in so you know where we are meeting and how to access the room.

The ROCK TEAM will monitor online behaviour during the sessions and we expect all the children to:

- Act as they would want others to act towards them.
- Be polite when they communicate with others online.

We also ask you and your children to follow the guidelines below:

- Please be appropriately dressed.
- Please be aware of your location when joining the zoom.
- Please make sure that the location of 'broadcast' is not in a bedroom.
- Please be aware of others in the household walking across the camera shot (e.g. people leaving the bathroom/shower).
- Please be aware of others talking/making noise in the household (e.g. we wouldn't want any inappropriate music or TV playing in background).

Please do not:

- Share personal details (e.g. contact details) about myself or others online.
- Use unkind, angry or bad language in the zoom room or in the chat function.
- Take screen shots without permission.
- Share on social media, screenshots/pictures of anyone without permission.
