Who Was Moses? - Reluctant Leader

Exodus 3:5-6, 9-11 _{NLT}

5 ... "Take off your sandals, for you are standing on holy ground.
 6 I am the God of your father ... Abraham, ... Isaac, ... Jacob."

⁹ Look! The cry of the people of Israel has reached me,... I have seen how harshly the Egyptians abuse them. ¹⁰ Now go, for I am sending you to Pharaoh. You must lead my people Israel out of Egypt." ¹¹ But Moses protested..., "Who am I to appear before Pharaoh? Who am I to lead the people... out of Egypt?"



Moses - Positioned By God...

Exodus 2:10-12 NLT

10 ...when the boy was older, his mother brought him back to Pharaoh's daughter, who adopted him as her own son. The princess named him Moses...

¹¹ Many years later, when Moses had grown up, he went out to visit his own people, the Hebrews, and he saw how hard they were forced to work. ...he saw an Egyptian beating one of his fellow Hebrews. ¹² After looking in all directions to make sure no one was watching, Moses killed the Egyptian and hid the body in the sand.

Hebrews 3:2, 5 _{NLT}

- ²...Moses served faithfully...entrusted with God's entire house.
- ⁵ Moses was certainly faithful in God's house as a servant. His work was an illustration of the truths God would reveal later.
