#### Mark 8:14-21 NLT

<sup>14</sup> But the disciples had forgotten to bring any food. They had only one loaf of bread with them in the boat. <sup>15</sup> As they were crossing the lake, Jesus warned them, "Watch out! Beware of the yeast of the Pharisees and of Herod." <sup>16</sup> At this they began to argue with each other... 17 Jesus knew what they were saying, so he said, "Why are you arguing about having no bread? Don't you know or understand even yet? Are your hearts too hard to take it in? 18 'You have eyescan't you see? You have ears-can't you hear?' Don't you remember anything at all? 19 When I fed the 5,000 with five loaves of bread, how many baskets of leftovers did you pick up afterward?" "Twelve," they said. 20 "And when I fed the 4,000 with seven loaves, how many large baskets of leftovers did you pick up?" "Seven," they said. <sup>21</sup> "Don't you understand yet?" he asked them.

## 2 Kings 6:14-17 NLT

<sup>14</sup> So one night the king of Aram sent a great army with many chariots and horses to surround the city. <sup>15</sup> When the servant of the man of God got up early the next morning and went outside, there were troops, horses, and chariots everywhere. "Oh, sir, what will we do now?" the young man cried to Elisha.

<sup>16</sup> "Don't be afraid!" Elisha told him. "For there are more on our side than on theirs!"

<sup>17</sup> Then Elisha prayed, "O LORD, open his eyes and let him see!" The LORD opened the young man's eyes, and when he looked up, he saw that the hillside around Elisha was filled with horses and chariots of fire.

<sup>10</sup> Meanwhile, Jacob left Beersheba and travelled toward Haran. <sup>11</sup> At sundown he arrived at a good place to set up camp and stopped there for the night. Jacob found a stone to rest his head against and lay down to sleep. <sup>12</sup> As he slept, he dreamed of a stairway that reached from the earth up to heaven. And he saw the angels of God going up and down the stairway. <sup>13</sup> At the top of the stairway stood the Lord, and he said, "I am the Lord, the God of your grandfather Abraham, and the God of your father, Isaac…

Are we aware of His... Presence, Power, Voice, Touch, Prompts, nudges, teachings?

## 3. Kingdom of Light and Darkness

**Two Kingdoms** - in opposition always: God's Kingdom Vs Satan's Kingdom but be aware **they are not equal!** 

Col 1:16 NKJV "For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers..."

Vs

Eph 6:12 κJV "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places."

Know this... God is Sovereign and he has no rival (Isaiah 40)

### 4. Role/Use of People

It is important to know that God uses people, so does the devil!!

Mark 8:31 NLT "31Then Jesus began to tell them that the Son of Man must suffer many terrible things and be rejected...He would be killed, but three days later he would rise from the dead. 32 As he talked about this openly with his disciples, Peter took him aside and began to reprimand him for saying such things. <sup>33</sup>Jesus turned around and looked at his disciples, then reprimanded Peter. "Get away from me, Satan!" he said. "You are seeing things merely from a human point of view, not from God's."

#### 5. Self Awareness

Self awareness ≠ heightened senses/ self centeredness or focus

It is knowing who and what you are, and can be!
