- **4.** What did Jesus say about 'growing'?

- 10. Not every seed is in good soil What improves our soil?
- Growing leads to "harvest" needs good Soil.
- **11.** Something is wanting to grow in your life! Ask yourself, "What is God germinating in me?" Write your response below:



**12.** Germination requires the right amount of time. The wrong timing will equal weak results

- 24. Understand God's Great Power
- **25.** Are you trusting in God?
- **26.** Are you growing towards God in these difficult circumstances?
