# Mi Kamocha in the Psalms

*“LORD, who is like You [mi kamocha], who delivers the afflicted from him who is too strong for him?” (Psalm 35:10).*

*“For Your righteousness, O God, reaches to the heavens, You who have done great things; O God, who is like You [mi kamocha]?” (Psalm 71:19).*

*“O LORD God of hosts, who is like You [mi kamocha], O mighty LORD? Your faithfulness also surrounds You” (Psalm 89:8).*

## Josiah reigned 640 to 609BC

In the 8th year of his reign, when he was 16 years old, he “began to seek the God of his ancestor David” (2 Chronicles 34:3).

In the 12th year of his reign, when he was 20 years old, he began to purify Judah and Jerusalem by destroying all pagan shrines, altars and idols.

In the 18th year of his reign, when he was 26 years old, he ordered the priests to repair the temple of the Lord which had not been maintained (2 Kings 22:3-6;. 2 Chronicles 34:8-11).

## John 5:

“<sup>19</sup> Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner. <sup>20</sup> For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel. <sup>21</sup> For as the Father raises the dead and gives life to *them*, even so the Son gives life to whom He will.
