Connect:

- 1. Why "involvement"? Why does involvement matter?
- 2. Read Psalm 22:3
- 3. Read John 1:14

Engage:

- 4. Read Luke 14:1
- 5. Can you imagine this scene? It was a set up... would Jesus "work" on a rest day? Yes, He healed a man – Jesus continually got involved with people.
- 6. Read <u>Luke 14:16-20</u>
- > Many Invitations 'Sent Out' by God:
 - Picture of Israel Old Testament invitations
 - Picture of today God continually invites people to come to Him
- > Banquet Ready Personal Invites come from God:
 - For the Jews at the time this came directly from Jesus
 - For us today, Jesus comes to us (Gentiles) through His church and the work of the Holy Spirit
- 7. What were the excuses?

- 8. Common Factors:
 - God Invites People (through others and work of Holy Spirit) "Involvement Matters"
 - Invite is NOT always convenient and will always interrupt something!
 - What we invest in can consume our focus

- 11. Read Luke 14:21-24
- 12. Why was He furious?
- 13. What goes into making a great banquet?
- > Detailed Preparation is always required, including:
 - Cost in Time
 - Pre-planning
 - Event Setup
 - Seating plan
 - Menu selection
 - Preparation Team
 - Serving Team
 - Entertainment
 - Finances

None of the above can be done without people's involvement.

- 14. There are 2 kinds of Kingdom involvement:
 - To respond to the invitation
 - To be part of delivery (of the Banquet for others)
- 15. Read <u>1 Kings 10:4-6</u>
- 16. People will be drawn to you, but what will they see on closer examination?
- 17. Who is God already inviting to the banquet in your world?
- 18. Who could you invite?
- 19. Read Ephesians 4:16
- 20. What has been the biggest impact on you personally during lockdown?
- 21. What new thing would you want God to do in your life?
