1 Corinthians 10:31b

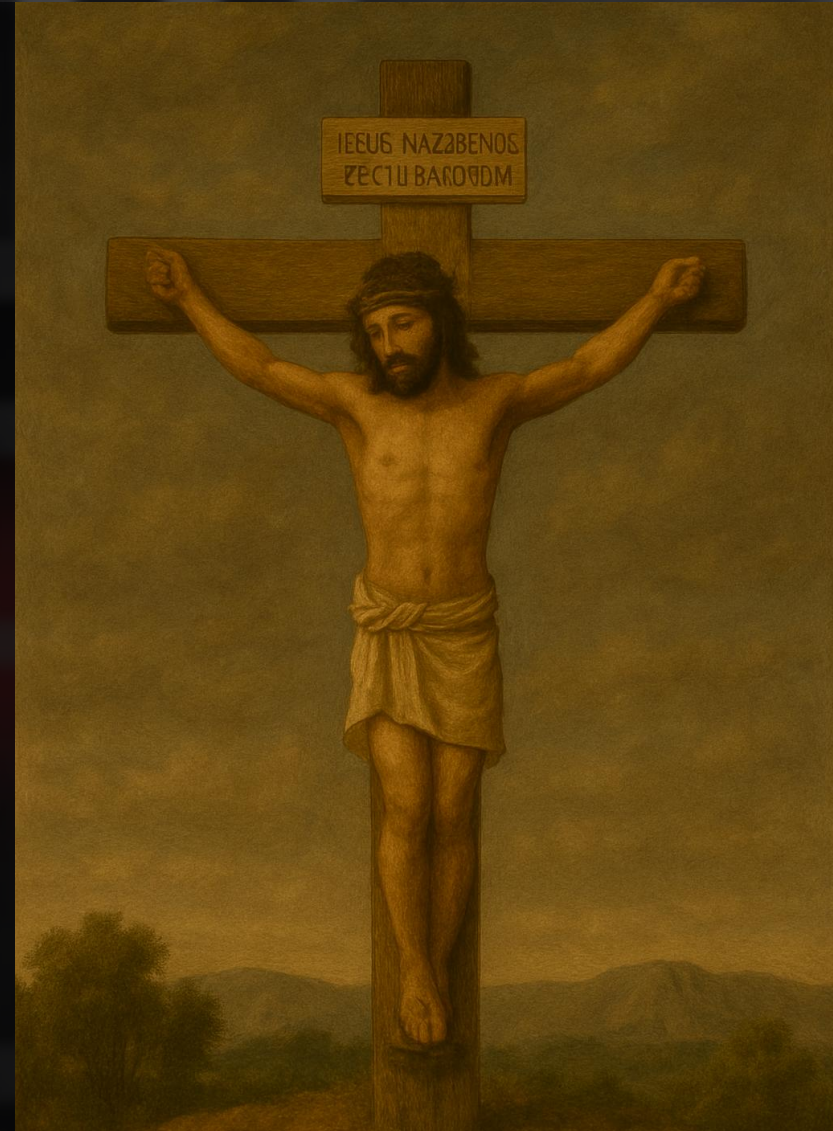
“... do all to the glory of God.”
