Connect:

- 1. What gifts has Jesus given to the church?
- 2. Read and discuss Ephesians 4:11-12
- 3. What gifts has God given you to use for His kingdom?
- 4. What is the purpose of being "equipped" with these ministry gifts?

Engage:

- 5. How does God call us?
- God firstly draws us to Himself FROM a set of circumstances, FROM a life without Him into a life with Him, FROM a lack of understanding to having understanding, FROM darkness to light
- God develops us THROUGH
- 6. Are you allowing God to develop you?
- 7. Are you being cooperative in the process of God developing you?
- God directs us TOWARDS
- 8. Do you trust God as He directs you? (Read John 10:27)
