Sacrificial Living

**“If Jesus Christ be God and died
for me, then no sacrifice can be
too great for me to make for
Him.”**

Leviticus 17:11 NKJV

‘For the life of the flesh *is* in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it *is* the blood *that* makes atonement for the soul.’

‘And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.’

Hebrew terms for 'sacrifice':

'zavach' זָבַח

refers only to animal offerings

'Korban' קָרְבָּן to draw close.

Hebrews 10:11-12 NKJV

‘And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. ¹² But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God’

Hebrews 13:15-16

15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of *our* lips, giving thanks to His name. **16** But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

Romans 12:1-2

'I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is your reasonable service.*

² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.'

1 Peter 2:5

‘you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual **sacrifices** acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.’
