## **Peace 'Within' Promised and Guaranteed**


John 14:27 NLT

# What does the Peace (Shalom) of Christ look like?





Isa. 26:3 "You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!"

Eph. 4:7 "...you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus."

## Why do we lose Peace?

#### Do we pray about everything?

Eph. 4:6-7 <sup>6</sup> Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. <sup>7</sup> Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

#### Do we get distracted, eyes off Jesus?

Psalm 121:1-2 <sup>1</sup> I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come? <sup>2</sup> My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth. He will not let your foot be moved; he who keeps you will not slumber.
