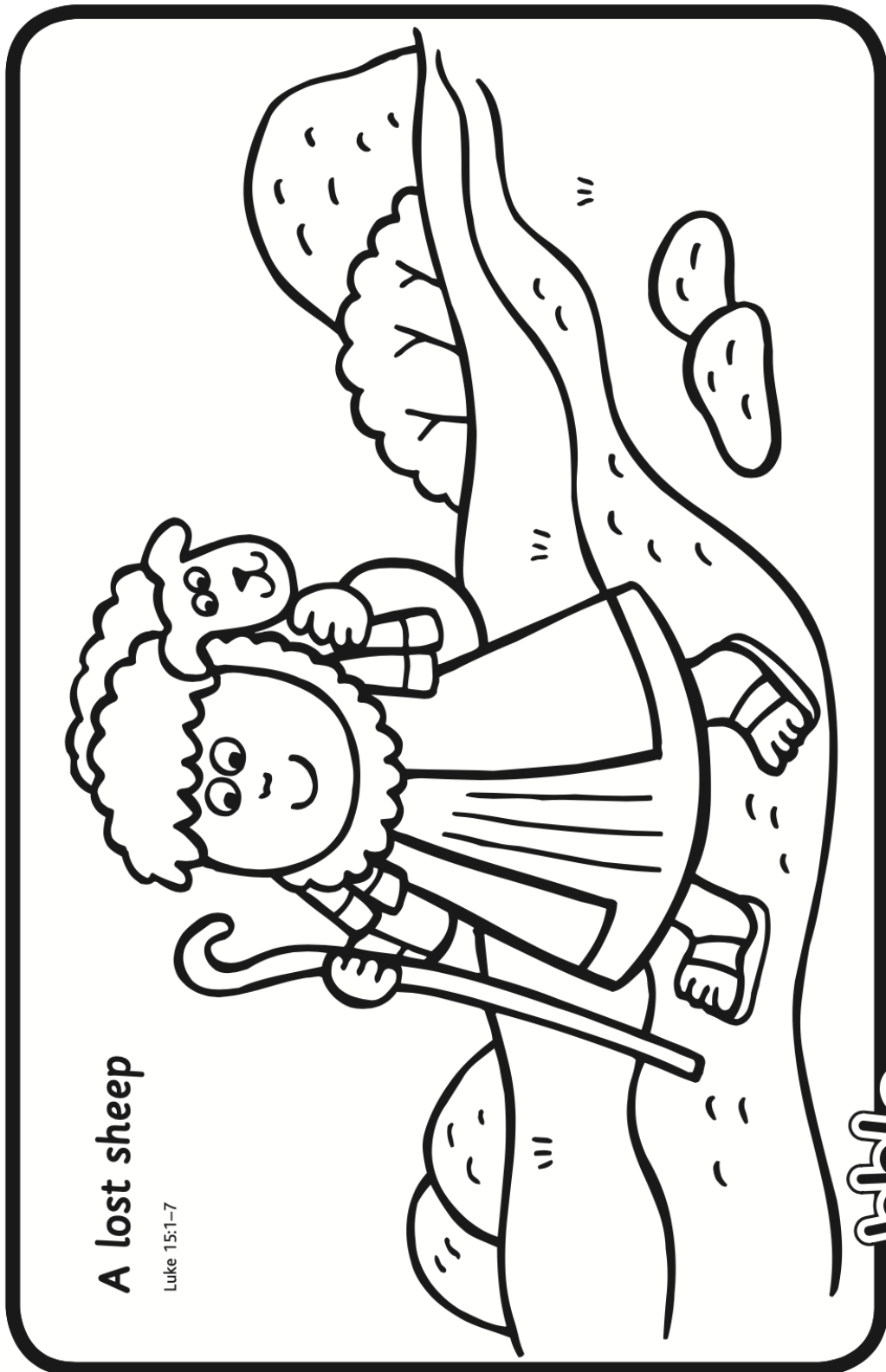

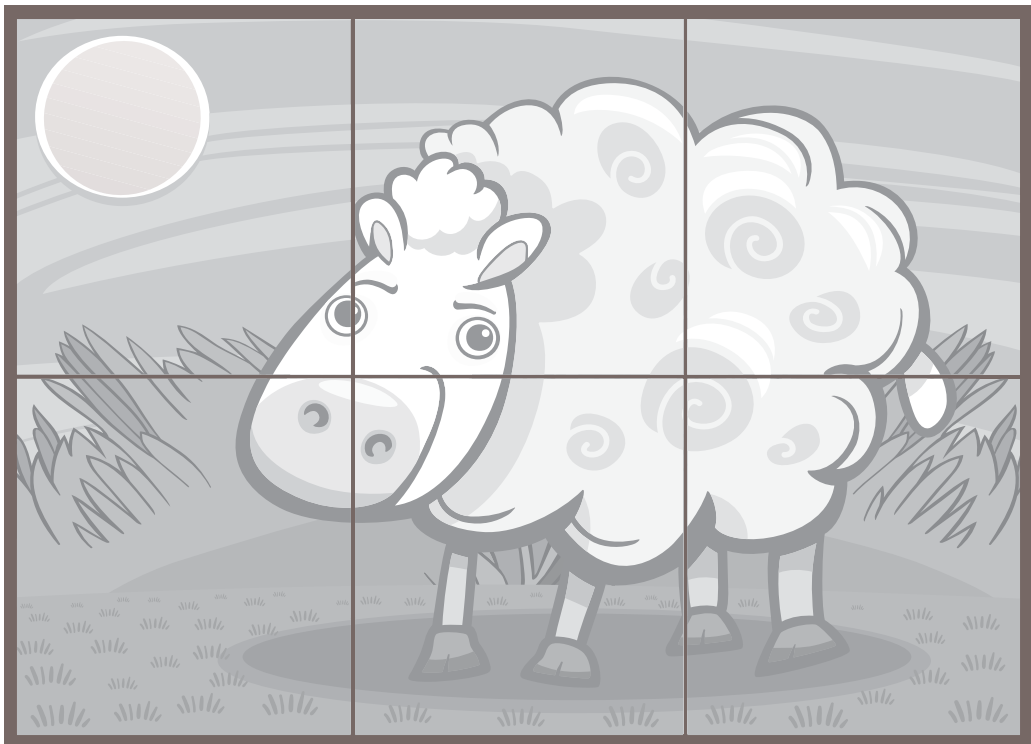
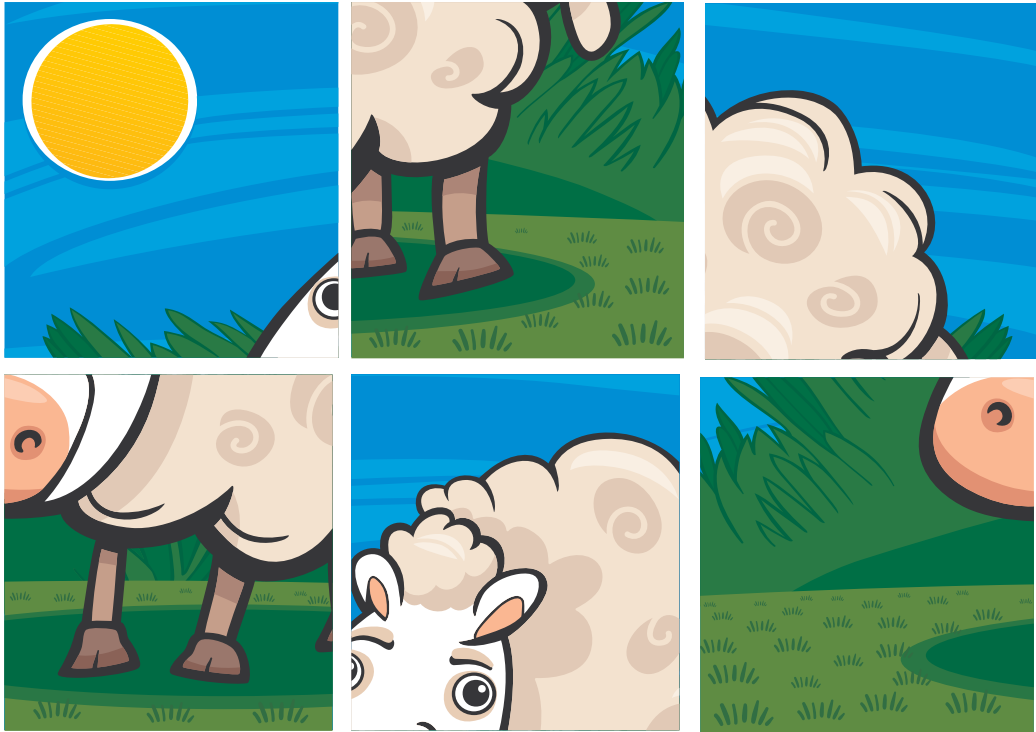

Young children have vivid imaginations and limited life knowledge.

This can lead them to feel fearful of simple things that do not seem to make sense to us as adults such as flushing the toilet, or being in the bedroom alone at night.

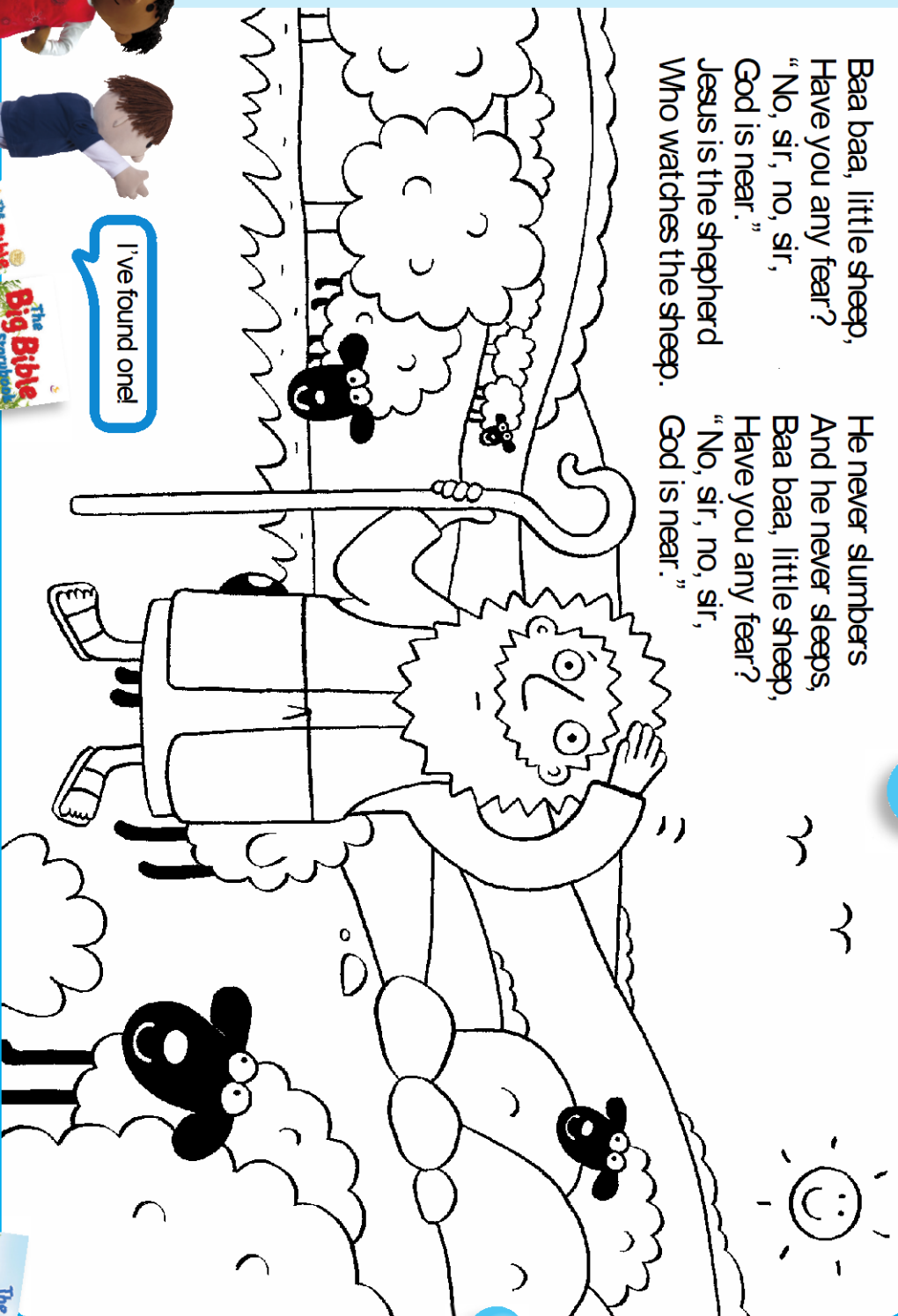
Sometimes we can help the child see that things like the shadows on the walls are caused by the curtains, or the headlights of the passing cars. It is important that we do not discount their anxiety or tell them "not to be stupid". Their feelings of fear are real. We can assure them that Jesus is always with them, even when we cannot be.
