#### John 6:44 NLT

<sup>44</sup> For no one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them to me, and at the last day I will raise them up.



# Being A Good Father – God's Pattern For Us?

#### 1. Relationship & Family (Belonging)

Psalm 103:13<sub>NLT</sub> David: "The Lord is like a father to his children, tender and compassionate...

#### 2. Provision & Protection (Blessing)

James 1:17 <sub>NLT</sub> Whatever is good and perfect is a gift coming down to us from God our Father.

#### 3. Prayer & Guidance (Becoming)

Matt 6:9 <sub>NLT</sub> Pray then like this: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name."



# Fatherhood – Divine Opportunity to Restore

#### Luke 15:20, 22-24 <sub>NLT</sub> "The Prodigal – Parable of the Lost Son"

<sup>20</sup> "So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him..."

<sup>22</sup> "...his father said to the servants, 'Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. Get a ring for his finger and sandals for his feet.
<sup>23</sup> And kill the calf we have been fattening. We must celebrate with a feast, <sup>24</sup> for this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found.' So the party began.



#### Luke 23:44-46 <sub>NIV</sub>

<sup>44</sup> ...darkness came over the whole land until three ... <sup>45</sup> for the sun stopped shining. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two.
<sup>46</sup> Jesus called out with a loud voice, 'Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.' When he had said this, he breathed his last.

#### John 20:16-17 NLT

<sup>16</sup> "Mary!" Jesus said. She turned to him and cried out, "Rabboni!" (which is Hebrew for "Teacher"). <sup>17</sup> "Don't cling to me," Jesus said, "for I haven't yet ascended to the Father. But go find my brothers and tell them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God."
