# What Does God Want Us to Remember?

1. God Loves us Deeply 1Jn 3:1 NIV “See what **great love the Father has lavished on us**, that we should be called children of God!”
2. Miracles are Real Psalm 78:7 NLT “...each generation should set its hope anew on God, **not forgetting his glorious miracles...**”
3. God Leads Through Storms Isaiah 43:2 NLT “When you go through deep waters, **I will be with you...through rivers of difficulty, you will not drown...through the fire of oppression, you will not be burned up; the flames will not consume you.**”
4. God Makes Perfect Plans Jeremiah 29:11 NLT “For I know the plans I have for you,” says the LORD. “They are **plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.**”

# 1. When Am I Waiting, He is Working...

Psalm 37:7 <sup>NLT</sup> <sup>37</sup> Be still in the presence of the Lord and wait patiently for him to act. Don't worry about evil people who prosper or fret about their wicked schemes.

Gal 6:9 <sup>NLT</sup> <sup>9</sup> So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.

Hab. 2:3 <sup>ESV</sup> <sup>3</sup> For still the vision awaits its appointed time; it hastens to the end—it will not lie. If it seems slow, wait for it; it will surely come; it will not delay.

## 2. When Its Time, Its Time...

Exodus 3:1-3 NLT

<sup>1</sup> One day Moses was tending the flock of his father-in-law... He led the flock far into the wilderness and came to Sinai... <sup>2</sup> There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a blazing fire from the middle of a bush. Moses stared in amazement. Though the bush was engulfed in flames, it didn't burn up. <sup>3</sup> "This is amazing," Moses said to himself. "Why isn't that bush burning up? I must go see it."



# 3. When He is Ready, Will I be Ready...?

Exodus 3:7, 10<sup>NLT</sup>

<sup>7</sup> Then the LORD told him, “I have certainly seen the oppression of my people in Egypt. **I have heard their cries of distress** because of their harsh slave drivers. Yes, **I am aware** of their suffering.

<sup>10</sup> **Now go, for I am sending you** to Pharaoh. You must lead my people Israel out of Egypt.

# 4. When a Miracle's Needed, it's Provided

Exodus 4:1-2 NLT

<sup>1</sup> But Moses protested again, “What if they won’t believe me or listen to me? What if they say, ‘The LORD never appeared to you’?” Then the LORD asked him, **“What is that in your hand?”** “A shepherd’s staff,” Moses replied.



# 5. When I Say Yes...God Continues to Bless!

Exodus 14:15-18 <sup>NLT</sup>

<sup>15</sup> Then the LORD said to Moses, “Why are you crying out to me? Tell the people to get moving! <sup>16</sup> **Pick up your staff and raise your hand over the sea.** Divide the water so the Israelites can walk through the middle of the sea on dry ground.

<sup>17</sup> ...**my great glory** will be displayed through Pharaoh and his troops, his chariots, and his charioteers. <sup>18</sup> When my glory is displayed through them, **all Egypt will see my glory and know that I am the LORD!**”
