## Know your Role / Purpose

Example: Deborah in Judges 4

<sup>4</sup> Deborah, the wife of Lappidoth, was a prophet who was judging Israel at that time. <sup>5</sup> She would sit under the Palm of Deborah, ... 6 One day she sent for Barak son of Abinoam, who lived in Kedesh in the land of Naphtali. She said to him, "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, commands you: Call out 10,000 warriors from the tribes of Naphtali and Zebulun at Mount Tabor. <sup>7</sup> And I will call out Sisera, commander of Jabin's army, along with his chariots and warriors,... There I will give you victory over him."

#### Example: Ananias in Acts 9 NLT

<sup>10</sup> In Damascus there was a disciple named Ananias. The Lord called to him in a vision, "Ananias!" "Yes, Lord," he answered. <sup>11</sup> The Lord told him, "Go to the house of Judas on Straight Street and ask for a man from Tarsus named Saul, for he is praying. <sup>12</sup> In a vision he has seen a man named Ananias come and place his hands on him to restore his sight."

13 "Lord," Ananias answered, "I have heard many reports about this man...

<sup>15</sup> But the Lord said to Ananias, "Go!...

<sup>17</sup> Then Ananias went to the house and entered it. Placing his hands on Saul, he said, "Brother Saul, …





#### Example: The unnamed maid and officers in 2 Kings 5

<sup>1</sup> But though Naaman was a mighty warrior, he suffered from leprosy. <sup>3</sup> One day the girl said to her mistress, "I wish my master would go to see the prophet in Samaria. He would heal him of his leprosy." <sup>4</sup> So Naaman told the king what the young girl from Israel had said. <sup>5</sup> "Go and visit the prophet,"

<sup>13</sup> But his officers tried to reason with him and said, "Sir, if the prophet had told you to do something very difficult, wouldn't you have done it? So you should certainly obey him when he says simply, 'Go and wash and be cured!'" <sup>14</sup> So Naaman went down to the Jordan River...
