Why Do We Need to Pray?

Genesis 1:26 NKJV

²⁶ Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion..."

Dominion = to tread down, to prevail against,

- to rule especially by curbing or restraining
- to exert control, direction or influence
- to spread out through a land through authority

We get back our authority and dominion power through prayer in the name of Jesus!



Why Do We Need to Pray?

Matthew18:18-20 NKJV (Matt 16:19)

¹⁸ "Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. ¹⁹ "Again I say to you that <u>if two of you agree</u> on earth concerning anything <u>that they ask</u>, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. ²⁰ For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

We Partner with the Sovereign LORD (YAHWEH) in Prayer! We become enforcement officers in Unity!



Effective Prayer Has Real Power

James 5:13-18 NKJV

¹³ Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms. ¹⁴ Is anyone among you sick? Let him ... ¹⁵ And the prayer of faith will save the sick,... And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

¹⁶ Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. ¹⁷ Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months. ¹⁸ And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit.



1. God's Ear

Isaiah 59:1 NIV

"Surely the arm of the Lord is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear."

Psalm 145:18 NIV

"The Lord is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth."

God is the God of heaven and earth-Remember, his ears are not stuck in heaven!



2. The Praying Person

Righteous: effective prayer has more to do with the one doing the praying than it does with "how" we are to pray.

1 Peter 3:12 NLT

¹² The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right, and his ears are open to their prayers.

Proverbs 15:8 NLT

⁸ The Lord detests the sacrifice of the wicked, but he delights in the prayers of the upright.



3. Faith and Right kind of 'Hope'

Mark 5:34 NKJV

34 "And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well..."

Hebrews 11:1 NIV

11 "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."

1John 5:14-15 NIV

14 "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. 15 And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him."

²⁶ "But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative -that is, the Holy Spirit- he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you."
