"God's Timing"

"It is a wonderful and necessary fact of political biology that we never know when our time is up."

'Boris Johnson had these prophetic words — his own — quoted back to him by *MP Munira Wilson* during PMQs on Wednesday, the day before he announced his resignation.'

1. God Created Shape and Time

Genesis 1:1-4 NLT

- ¹ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
- ² The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters. ³ Then God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. ⁴ And God saw that the light was good. Then he separated the light from the darkness.
- ⁵ God called the light "day" and the darkness "night." And evening passed and morning came, marking the first day.

2. God Works to His Own Plan

Genesis 18:1-2, 9-10 NLT

- ¹ The Lord appeared to Abraham near the great trees of Mamre while he was sitting at the entrance to his tent in the heat of the day. ² Abraham looked up and saw three men standing nearby...
- ⁹ 'Where is your wife Sarah?' they asked him. 'There, in the tent,' he said. ¹⁰ Then one of them said, 'I will surely return to you about this time next year, and Sarah your wife will have a son.' Now Sarah was listening at the entrance to the tent, which was behind him.

3. God Has 'Appointed' Times (Divine Shift)

Genesis 18:11-14 NLT

11 Abraham and Sarah were already very old, and Sarah was past the age of childbearing. 12 So Sarah laughed to herself as she thought, 'After I am worn out and my lord (Abraham) is old, will I now have this pleasure?' 13 Then the Lord said to Abraham, 'Why did Sarah laugh and say, "Will I really have a child, now that I am old?" 14 Is anything too hard for the Lord? I will return to you at the appointed time next year, and Sarah will have a son.'

4. Principles of God's Timing

He Keeps His Own Calendar: 2 Peter 3:8 (NLT)

⁸ But you must not forget this one thing, dear friends: A day is like a thousand years to the Lord, and a thousand years is like a day.

He Requires our Patience: Psalm 37:7 (NLT) ⁷ Be still in the presence of the LORD, and wait patiently for him to act.

5. "God's Way is Perfect" (Ps 18:30)

Galatians 4:4 (NLT)

⁴ But when the right time (*Chronos*) came, God sent his Son, born of a woman, subject to the law. ⁵ God sent him to buy freedom for us who were slaves to the law, so that he could adopt us as his very own children.

Romans 9:9 (NLT)

⁹ For God had promised, "I will return about this time (*Kairos*) next year, and Sarah will have a son."

6. Can People Miss Divine 'Moments'?

Matt 25:3-4, 10 (NLT) Parable of 10 Bridesmaids

³ The five who were foolish didn't take enough olive oil for their lamps, ⁴ but the other five were wise enough to take along extra oil.

¹⁰ "But while they were gone to buy oil, the bridegroom came. Then those who were ready went in with him to the marriage feast, and the door was locked.

7. Discover Kingdom Rhythm (Timing)

- a) Let God Change Me: Psalm 40:3 (NLT)
 He has given me a new song to sing, a hymn of praise to our God.
 Many will see what he has done and be amazed. They will put their trust in the LORD.
- b) Let His Richness Fill Me: Colossians 3:16 (NLT)

 16 Let the message about Christ, in <u>all its richness</u>, fill your lives...

 Sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts.
- c) Let His Love Be Seen In Me: Galatians 6:9 (NLT)

 ⁴ So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time (Kairos) we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.
