
1 Chronicles 12:32

Number 32:12 'except Caleb the son of Jephunneh, the Kenizzite, and Joshua the son of Nun, for they have <u>wholly followed the LORD</u>.'

Deuteronomy 31:23 '<u>Then He inaugurated</u> Joshua the son of Nun, and said, "Be strong and of good courage; for you shall bring the children of Israel into the land of which I swore to them, and I will be with you."





Joshua – walking with the Lord and pursuing Him

Deuteronomy 34:9 'Now Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him; so the children of Israel heeded him, and did as the LORD had commanded Moses.'

Exodus 33:11 'So the LORD spoke to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend. And he would return to the camp, but his servant Joshua the son of Nun, a young man, did not depart from the tabernacle.'





Joshua – Encountering the Lord

Joshua 5:13-15

¹³ 'And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, a Man stood opposite him with His sword drawn in His hand. And Joshua went to Him and said to Him, "Are You for us or for our adversaries?" ¹⁴ So He said, "No, but as Commander of the army of the LORD I have now come." And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshiped, and said to Him, "What does my Lord say to His servant?" ¹⁵ Then the Commander of the Lord's army said to Joshua, "Take your sandal off your foot, for the place where you stand is holy." And Joshua did so.'

Joshua – Intimacy led to encounter

1. Joshua's desire as a young man was to be in God's presence.

2. This led to intimacy. When he was eventually called to lead God's people he had already established a pattern in his life which led to encounter.

3. Encounter allowed him to receive strategy.
