- 8. Ephesians Chapter 3 Paul wants to build the confidence of the Gentile believers. He reminds them he is a prisoner for their benefit Gentiles are important to God not 2nd class.
- 9. The message was going to the gentiles, because of Paul's obedience!

10. What is God-Given confidence? (It starts with really knowing God)

"When I think of all this, I, Paul, a prisoner of Christ Jesus for the benefit of you Gentiles. . . assuming, by the way, that you know God gave me the special responsibility of extending his grace to you Gentiles. As I briefly wrote earlier, God himself revealed his mysterious plan to me."

- ➤ He Wrote to the Ephesians, Colossians and Philemon

# Your Journey A->B:

- Step 1: Eyes off ME, onto HIM
- Step 2: Feet firmly on His path "trust as He leads"
- Step 3: Recognise God's blessing

- 17. **Test:** Is God blessing what I'm doing?
- 18. What are God's blessings

- The Lord source of material blessing; 'Keep you' divine protection, victory

- 'Turn His Face' divine favour, approval; Peace/shalom, balance and absence of strife
- 20. God speaking NOW: "The Blessing" based on Exodus 6
