

Risks can come from various sources including uncertainty in international markets, political instability, threats from project failures (at any phase in design, development, production, or sustaining of life-cycles), legal liabilities, credit risk, accidents, natural causes and disasters, deliberate attack from an adversary, or events of uncertain or unpredictable root-cause.







































Risk taking is any consciously or non-consciously controlled behaviour with a perceived uncertainty about its outcome, and/or about its possible benefits or costs for the physical, economic or psycho-social well-being of oneself or others.

¹³ Mordecai had this message delivered to Esther: "Do not imagine that you of all the Jews, will escape with your life by being in the king's palace. ¹⁴ On the contrary, if you keep silence in this crisis, relief and deliverance will come to the Jews from another quarter, while you and your father's house will perish.
