1st Meeting Only Facilitator's Guide

Note: Before beginning a new book, encourage the group to read an overview of it in a study Bible or commentary.

Before the Group time

- Fill in the information in the PREPARE section. Write in the Scripture reference and only one to three sentences for the overview and what the passage is about. Use a study Bible or commentary for information on the book and passage.
- Pray for the group and depend on the Holy Spirit to lead, guide, and bless your time together.
- *Important*: Statements in brackets are instructions for you. Statements in **bold** are what you say to the group.

Beginning the Group time

- [Begin with a brief chitchat time.] How are things going? How are you doing?
- · Let's begin with prayer.
- **Let me first explain the DBE Process**. [Hand out the *DBE Process* page and briefly explain each part.]
- [Next, hand out the *Discovery Bible Experience*, and briefly explain each part on all 4 pages.]
- [After explaining the *Discovery Bible Experience*, continue with the following PREPARE section.]

PREPARE

 Let's start with page 1. Take a moment and read only the Remember section. Just look up when you ar done.]
• [When everyone is finished the <i>Remember</i> section, continue with the following:]
• Now, let each of us <i>silently</i> do <i>both</i> bullet points in the <i>Pray</i> section. Just look up when you are done.

• The Scripture passage for our time is: _	·
Before we read it, the book of	. [Give a <i>brief</i> purpose or overview of the book.]

• **This passage** [Repeat the passage reference and give a *brief* statement of what this passage is about.]

- Let's continue on page 2 with the Scripture Passage for our time.
- [Read the instruction below, which is the same as the bullet point instruction on the top of page 2.]
- Take a minute or two and read the passage silently before we begin discussing each verse separately.
- · Just look up when you are done.
- [Turn this page over while the group is reading the passage.]

• [When everyone is finished, continue with the following:]

• [When everyone is finished reading the Scripture on page 2, continue with the following EXPLORE section.]

EXPLORE

- Let's do the EXPLORE section, beginning on the top of page 3.
- [Read the instruction below, which is the same as the bullet point instruction on the top of page 3.]
- As a group, we will read and discuss the passage *one verse at a time*. Write the verse number in the left column and write down any thoughts or notes during the discussion.
- **Look at the first verse.** [Read the verse out loud and then use the Group Discussion question below.]

Group Discussion question

- What do you see or observe in this verse (a truth, insight, key word)? Share what you see or observe.
- [Allow time for responses and repeat the question as needed to encourage discussion.]
- [If needed, ask any of the following additional questions.]
 - Does anything get your attention or interest in this verse?
 - What does [insert a word or phrase from the verse] mean or imply?
 - Does this verse raise any questions?
 - Is there anything else you see or observe?
- [After *each verse* is discussed, *say*:] **Look at the next verse**. [Read it out loud, or ask someone to read it, then start exploring the verse with the first Group Discussion question above.]
- [After all the verses have been discussed, continue with the following FOCUS and RESPOND sections.]

FOCUS and RESPOND

- Turn to page 4 and follow along as I read the FOCUS instruction and both parts a & b. [Read them.]
- Now continue on your own and do as much of the FOCUS and RESPOND sections as you can during this time.
- [Let the group continue working on page 4 *until six to seven minutes before the end of the meeting time*. At that time, continue with the following Concluding the Group time section.]

Concluding the Group time

- If you did not finish all of the FOCUS and RESPOND sections at this time, it's important to complete them on your own in the next day or so.
- Before we're done, let's each share *only* what we're focusing on—what we wrote in FOCUS section a, on page 4.
- [After everyone shares their FOCUS, *emphasize* the following:]
- This week, after finishing your FOCUS and RESPOND, do the FOLLOW THROUGH on the bottom of page 4.
- The FOLLOW THROUGH is what really makes the difference. It will help you hear more clearly from God.
- Proverbs 4:7b in the Voice Bible says: Now, whatever else you do, follow through to understanding.
- Take 10-15 minutes, at least 2 or 3 times in the next several days, to let God's Word work in your life.
