Connect:

- 1. The Truth gives confidence in decision making and trust in circumstances.
- 2. Hearing God: Some may ridicule it, some don't realise it and others just don't want it.
- 3. Some religions say you can't hear directly from God, others say you must empty yourself. But Christianity gives direct access to God.
- 4. Why is hearing God important?

"I am not a product of my circumstances. I am a product of my decisions." Stephen Covey

Engage:

5. How do you make decisions?

"When making a decision, we form opinions and choose actions via mental processes which are influenced by <u>biases</u>, <u>reason</u>, <u>emotions</u>, and <u>memories</u>. The simple act of deciding supports the notion that we have <u>free will</u>. We weigh the benefits and costs of our choice, and then we cope with the consequences." Psychology Today

- 6. What about spiritual influences?
 - Human factors limit the ability to make good decisions. These include preconceptions, incomplete information, urgent deadlines, limited physical or emotional resources and difficult past.
- 7. What does this say to us about the concept of 'free will'?
- 8. Read <u>Genesis 2:15-17</u>
- 9. Read Genesis 3:1
- 10. Have you ever been tempted to do something wrong? How?
 - Temptation causes us think, consider and do it
 - The same pattern occurs with the way God communicates

- 11. The TRUTH about hearing God is that He speaks to us long before we choose to respond to His call (Salvation). Then the exciting journey begins; with new discoveries to make.
- 12. Is your journey strongly guided by God or do you feel stuck?
- 13. Why does hearing God speak matter?
- 14. "And God spoke" (or similar) is referenced many times in the Bible:
 - Shows I Truly Know Him In His Family John 10:27 "My sheep listen to my voice, I know them... they follow me."
 - Stops me Making Unnecessary Mistakes 'Best' Route forward Psalm 32:8 "I will guide you along the <u>best pathway</u> for your life..."
 - Strengthens Everything I Do Helps me Learn: Successful and Safe Psalm 32:8 "...I will <u>advise you</u> and watch over you."

15. If necessary, God speaks in different and unusual ways:

- <u>Romans 1:20</u> God through Creation speaks to **the whole world**
- <u>Genesis 41:1-7</u> God spoke to **pharaoh in dreams** (pagan kings)
- Daniel 5:5-6 God spoke in handwriting on the wall to Belshazzar
- Exodus 3:2-3 God spoke to Moses in a burning bush (Prince of Egypt)
- Numbers 22:28 God even spoke through a donkey to Balaam

Framework:

<u>Learning to Hear God Speak – The General Rule:</u> "The Cleaner MY life, the Clearer I'll HEAR God Speak" *Pastor Mark Wiltshire*

- 16. Read <u>1 Samuel 3:1-5</u>
- 17. When God spoke to Elijah (in a cave on Mount Sinai, Egypt), He spoke not in a mighty wind, earthquake or fire, but in 'the sound of a gentle whisper...' (1 Kings 19:11-13)
- 18. How does God speak today?
- 19. Work of God's Holy Spirit (examples in scriptures):
 - God's Word (Bible) 2 Timothy 3:16
 - Prayer/Worship (Whisper) <u>1 Kings 19</u>
 - Visions/Pictures Jeremiah 1:11
 - Dreams <u>Genesis 31:24</u>
 - Through someone else <u>1 Thessalonians 5:11</u>
 - Impression in your Spirit John 16:13
 - Spiritual gifts <u>1 Corinthians 12</u>
- 20. Have you or someone you know experienced any of these different ways?
- 21. What impact did it have?
- 22. How do you know it's really God speaking?
- 23. 3 key tests to know if it's really God speaking:
 - **"Scripture" Test** Does what you hear agree with God's written word? Does it honour Him?
 - **"Peace" Test** Does what you hear take you to a place of confidence, trust, and peace?



- **"Fruitfulness" Test** When you act on what you hear, do you see the positive Kingdom outcomes you expected?
- 24. Read Philippians 4:6-7
- 25. What other ways can you have confidence that you are hearing God speak?
- 26. What changes when you hear God speak?
- 27. Read <u>Psalm 99:6</u>
 - > Samuel learned to hear and when to ask for help
- 28. Do you give up too soon? (God's ways are often not our ways)
 - Samuel became a priest after Eli God trusts us with leadership
 - He was appointed as a Judge to the Nation God gives greater responsibilities (Anointed the first 2 Kings – Saul and David)
 - > Prophet to the Nation (reliable and trusted, even after his death)
- 29. What could God do in your life when you learn to really hear Him?
- 30. Do you feel unsatisfied or disillusioned at times?
- *31.* The TRUTH about hearing God, is that it is available to all who will listen.
