# God's nature... in His promises

2 Cor. 9:8 NIV <sup>8</sup> And God is able to **bless you abundantly**, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.

Eph 3: 20 NIV <sup>20</sup> Now to him who is **able to do immeasurably more** than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us

Phil. 4: 19 NIV <sup>19</sup> And my God will **meet all your needs** according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.

# How do we partner with God?

## 1) Trusting Him in new areas of our lives

Exodus 4: 20<sub>NIV</sub><sup>20</sup> So Moses took his wife and sons, put them on a donkey and started back to Egypt. And he took the staff of God in his hand.

## 2) Taking Him at his word

Proverbs 16: 20<sub>NIV</sub><sup>20</sup> Whoever gives heed to instruction prospers and blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD.

## 3) Reliance on Him

Num. 12:3<sub>NIV</sub><sup>3</sup> (Now Moses was a very humble man, more humble than anyone else on the face of the earth.)
